

NetZero Flame Arrestor Removal Instructions

Note: This process is required before you can operate the fuel pump.



REQUIRED TOOLS

Flame Arrestor Removal Tool (Provided with Burner)

REMOVING THE FLAME ARRESTOR

The bottle the fuel arrives in is fitted with a safety device for your protection, known as a 'Flame Arrestor'. It keeps any sparks or flame from inadvertently entering the bottle causing the fuel within to ignite. NetZero already takes steps to ensure safe filling of your burner. That is accomplished via the enclosed pump which requires you place a fill hose into the bottle. In order to do so, you will need to remove the flame arrestor from the throat of the bottle. This is simple to accomplish using the enclosed flame arrestor removal tool.

Follow these steps to remove the flame arrestor as shown.



- 1) Place the end of the tool directly on top of the flame arrestor and give it a few taps with a hammer or other blunt object. This will push the flame arrestor down into the bottle and out of the way.
- 2) Place the fill hose into the bottle per the operating instructions for your NetZero burner.
