FINISHING THE FIREBOX

The firebox comes with optional finishing guides. These guides install to the front face of the firebox. They provide an edge that can be finished up to with finishing material and will then cover the cut edge of the finishing material. The guides protrude 1/2 inch from the face of the firebox. For the best results use 1/2 inch thick finishing material with the guides.

Install the guides using the included rivets or screws. If using the deflector at the top of the firebox the deflector will serve as the top guide. After installing the guides verify that the guides meet in the corners and that the opening matches the dimensions below.





KIT CONTENTS

NOTE: If you have a grace front, the grace frame will be attached to the screen already.

It is not required to use the screen with the grace front. If desired, the screen can be removed by removing the screws on the back of the screen.





MOUNTING THE SAFETY SCREEN OR GRACE FRONT ONTO THE FIREBOX

ATTACHING BRACKETS TO THE FIREBOX

Attach the brackets to the side of the firebox with the provided screws. The brackets are different for each side. Ensure the screen tab is oriented towards the bottom. Set the hanging brackets to the desired screen or front depth and tighten the screws to the firebox with a phillips screwdriver. The brackets can be set to varying depths, flush with the front of the firebox at a minimum to a maximum of 3" from the face of the firebox.



ATTACHING THE SCREEN OR GRACE FRONT TO THE BRACKETS

The screen or grace front is attached to the brackets using magnets. To attach the screen or grace front to the brackets, place the bottom of the screen against the screen tab and gently push the screen or grace front towards the hanging bracket- the magnets will secure it into place. The screen or grace front can be moved up or down slightly to ensure the gap on all sides is consistent. The screen or grace front are symmetrical, there is not a designated top or bottom.





REMOVING THE SCREEN OR GRACE FRONT FROM THE BRACKETS

To remove the safety screen or grace from the magnetic brackets use the screen removal tool.

- 1. Turn the tool sideways and and slide it into the gap between the top guide and the top of the screen until the hook is past the backside of the screen.
- 2. Rotate the tool 90 degrees to rotate the hook downwards to make contact with the back side of the screen.
- 3. Pull the tool towards you to disengage the magnetic attraction between the screen and the bracket.
